Item 7(d)(1): For informational purposes only, Board Members were provided a copy of a Fiscal Report – President Biden Proposes Significant Ongoing Education Funding Increases, which includes a \$2.6 billion increase to Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) and \$250 million increase to IDEA Part C.
