Independent Contractor Agreement with Haynes Family of Programs – S.T.A.R. Academy, to add the additional service of Educationally Related Intensive Counseling Services (ERICS), at a rate of \$120 per hour. Services are to be one hour per week for the period of April 6, 2020 through February 22, 2020 (total of 35 weeks/hours). Total contract costs increase from \$16,000 to \$20,200. Effective April 6, 2020 through June 30, 2020. All other terms and conditions remain the same.

g. It is recommended that the Board approve the Participation Agreement with Exhibit 8 the Orange County Department of Education to provide LEA services regarding

the GASELPA's Medi-Cal Administrative Activities (MAA). Cost: 1) 4.5% of the GASELPA's reimbursement from the State; 2) \$.67 per GASELPA participant each month for July-September 2020 and \$1.34 per GASELPA participant each quarter thereafter; 3) proportionate share of the State Participant fees and 4) 2% of States costs for administering School-based MAA claiming services (preparation of quarterly invoices). Term is July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021.

h. It is recommended that the Board approve the Amendment to the Section 125 Flexible Benefit Plan, incorporating changes in the definition of medical Expense related to the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), effective for medical expenses incurred after December 31, 2019. All other terms and conditions remain in full force.

i. It is recommended that the Board approve the Consulting Services
Agreement with Total Compensation Systems, Inc. to provide GASB 74/75

11. ACTION DISCUSSION
