- F. It is recommended that the Board approve the License Agreement between the San Joaquin County Office of Education (Provider) and the Greater Anaheim SELPA (Customer). Provider has created and is owner of a web-based suite of tools, known as the Special Education Information System (SEIS), for use by special education programs in formulating, updating, tracking, storing and reporting on Pupil Records, including Individualized Education Plans (IEP). Costs are based on current student count in SEIS as of February 2, 2025. In the event the Customer's most recent Student Count is 10% greater or less than 7,826, the following License Fees shall be revised proportionately according to the Provider's then current fee schedule: FY 2025/26 \$74,347, FY 2026/27 \$74,347 and FY 2027/28 \$74,347. Agreement is effective July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2028. Member districts to reimburse.
