- f. It is recommended that the Board approve the Independent Contractor Agreement with Marshall B. Ketchum University, to provide vision assessment, exams and vision therapy. Costs are per the attached rate sheet. Effective October 15, 2025 through June 30, 2026. Member districts to reimburse.
- g. It is recommended that the Board approve the Agreement Between The University of California, San Diego, School of Medicine, Department of Pediatrics and The Greater Anaheim SELPA Education Local Plan Area Concerning Consulting Services. Services to be provided are medical consultation as requested by SELPA, which may include Health-related needs; interactions on behalf of the SELPA with students' physicians; definition of "medical necessity" for speech and for occupational and physical therapies

- with prescriptions for services received by students of the SELPA. Cost is \$280 per hour and total costs not to exceed \$100,000. Effective September 1, 2025 through August 31, 2027.
- h. It is recommended that the Board approve the Participation in the Parent Infant Education and Support Program Income Agreement (PIES) between the Orange County Superintendent of Schools (OCDE) and the Greater Anaheim SELPA. OCDE will provide educational programs for infants with hearing loss. Cost is \$1851.58 per infant per month. Total costs not to exceed \$66,656.88. Effective July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026. Part C to provide funding.

# 11. ACTION DISCUSSION

- a. It is recommended that the Board adopt the Meal & Incidental Exhibit 8 Expense Policy BP 3551.
- b. It is recommended that the Board approve the Independent Contractor Exhibit 9 Agreement with ProCare Therapy, to provide Sign Language Interpreters (SLI) at \$85-\$95 per hour, Registered Nurses (RN) at \$88-\$93 per hour, and Licensed Practical Nurses (LPN) at \$78.75-\$83 per hour. Effective October 15, 2025 through June 30, 2026. Member districts to reimburse.
- c. It is recommended that the Board accept the Greater Anaheim SELPA's Exhibit 10 2024-25 Annual Audit prepared by Silva & Silva, CPAs.
