

## GREATER ANAHEIM SPECIAL EDUCATION LOCAL PLAN AREA

### **Board Meeting Highlights February 20, 2019**

Item 8(c): Board Members were provided with copies of the agendas for the February 2019 State SELPA meetings. Board Members were also provided with copies of the February 2019 State SELPA Committee Summaries.

Item 8(d)(1): Board Members reviewed information from the Coalition for Adequate Funding for Special Education outlining Governor Newsom's proposed "Special Education Concentration Grant", which is limited to LEAs with an Unduplicated Pupil Percentage (UPP) of 55% and the percentage of students with disabilities must exceed the state average currently at 10.93%.

Item 8(d)(2): Board Members reviewed information from the Coalition for Adequate Funding for Special Education, outlining information from the Legislative Analyst's Office which expresses concerns about the proposal for Special Education funding in the 2019-20 State Budget.

Item 8(e)(1): Board Members were updated on a new bill that has been introduced, AB 428 (Medina) – Special Education Finance Reform. This bill proposes the following funding for Special Education: 1) a funding mechanism to support Special Education preschool programs, 2) address inequities by equalizing special education funding rates, 3) provides a supplemental grant to support students with greater needs and 4) allow districts the ability to calculate on declining enrollment, rather than SELPA ADA.

Item 8(e)(2): Board Members reviewed the School Services of California/Coalition for Adequate Funding for Special Education – Legislative Report dated January 24, 2019.

Item 8(f)(1): For informational purposes only, Board Members were provided with a copy of a flyer regarding an upcoming CAC Parent Training to be held on March 26, 2019 on the topic of "Preparing for Adult Transition".

Item 8(g): Board Members reviewed a listing of the Trainings/Staff Developments that were conducted by GASELPA staff members during the month of January 2019.

Item 9(a): Board Members reviewed the December 1, 2018 – Greater Anaheim SELPA – California Special Education Management Information System (CASEMIS) report.
