Board Meeting Highlights March 20, 2019

Item 7(c): Board Members were provided with copies of the agendas for the March 2019 State SELPA meetings. Board Members were also provided with copies of the March 2019 State SELPA Committee Summaries.

Item 7(d)(1): Board Members reviewed information from the Coalition for Adequate Funding for Special Education, regarding "Total Special Education Expenditures Supported By State, Federal and Local Funds". The percentages of cost covered by each funding source in 2017-18 were: State-25.71% (decrease), Federal-8.4% (decrease) and Local General Fund Contribution -65.88% (increase).
