- f. It is recommended that the Board approve Amendment No. 1 to the Independent Contractor Agreement with Olive Crest to add Medium Support Intervention services at a rate of \$750 per week. Total contract costs to increase from \$10,000 to \$19,000, effective April 14, 2021 through June 30, 2021. Member district to reimburse. Exhibit 9
- g. It is recommended that the Board approve the Participation Agreement with the Orange County Department of Education to provide LEA services regarding the GASELPA's Medi-Cal Administrative Activities (MAA). Cost: 1) 4.5% of the GASELPA's reimbursement from the State; 2) \$.67 per GASELPA participant each month for July-September 2020 and \$1.34 per GASELPA participant each quarter thereafter; 3) proportionate share of the State Participant fees and 4) 2% of States costs for administering School-based MAA claiming services (preparation of quarterly invoices). Term is July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022. Exhibit 10

**10. ACTION DISCUSSION**

- a. It is recommended that the Board approve the Independent Contractor Agreement with Auditory Instruments, Inc., to provide Central Auditory Processing Dysfunction/Disorder Evaluations and Independent Educational Audiological Evaluations. Costs are \$2,500 for Processing Dysfunction/Disorder Evaluation and \$1,800 for Independent Educational Audiological Evaluation. Both evaluations include document review, school observation, parent and/or teacher questionnaires, report with recommendations, and up to 2 hours IEP participation. Total costs not to exceed \$5,000. Effective April 22m, 2021 through June 30, 2021. Member districts to reimburse. Exhibit 11
- b. It is recommended that the Board approve the Independent Contractor Agreement with Endleman & Associates to provide Independent Educational Evaluation (IEE): Comprehensive Psychoeducational Assessment. Costs are a \$5,000 per assessment which includes testing, observation, interpretive report and IEP meeting attendance. Total Costs not to exceed \$5,000. Effective March 25, 2021 through June 30, 2021. Member district to reimburse. Exhibit 12
- c. It is recommended that the Board approve the Independent Contractor Agreement with Pliha Speech & Learning Center to provide tutoring services Academic Evaluations. Costs are \$95 per hour for tutoring services and \$1,500 per Academic Evaluations, with total costs not to exceed \$10,000. Effective May 1, 2021 through June 30, 2021. Member district to reimburse. Exhibit 13
- d. It is recommended that the Board approve the Independent Contractor Agreement with Robin L. Morris, Psy.D, L.M.F.T., to provide Independent Educational Evaluation (IEE). Cost is \$5,000 per evaluation, which includes review of records, school observation, parent and teacher questionnaires, report with recommendations, and up to 2 hour IEP by phone. Total costs not to exceed \$5,000. Effective March 31, 2021 through June 30, 2021. Member district to reimburse. Exhibit 14
- e. It is recommended that the Board approve the First Amendment to Special Exhibit 15

Education Information System License Agreement. Amendment would add additional service of SEISsign at a cost of 880.25 for 2020-21 and \$1,760.50 for 2021-22. Effective March 15, 2021 through June 30, 2022. Member districts to reimburse.

- f. It is recommended that the Board approve the CODESTACK Memorandum of Contract – Programming and Maintenance of SEIS/SIS Integration Components and Services. Memorandum would add an additional member district integration components and services to allow bidirectional data transfer between SEIS and the district’s SIS system. Cost is \$4,000 for implementation and an annual maintenance of \$1.50 per student based on Eligible and Pending Student Count, with the first annual maintenance of \$480, with subsequent annual fees assessed every 12 months. Effective March 12, 2021 for a term of 36 months. Member district to reimburse. Exhibit 16
- g. It is recommended that the Board approve all Greater Anaheim SELPA certificated, classified and contracted (Executive Director and Director of Business Operations) staff members the same 3% salary increase retroactive to July 1, 2020 that may be adopted by the Anaheim Union High School District Board of Trustees, with the understanding that those GASELPA staff members hired through the Cypress School District and assigned to the GASELPA will be subject only to the agreement approved/adopted by the Cypress School District Board of Trustees. Approval is contingent/pending upon the Anaheim Union High School District Board of Trustees final approval.
- h. It is recommended that the Board approve increasing for all GASELPA certificated and contracted (Executive Director) staff members the same increase to Longevity and Doctorate Stipend retroactive to July 1, 2020 that may be approved by the Anaheim Union High School District Board of Trustees, with the understanding that those certificated GASELPA staff members hired through the Cypress School District and assigned to the GASELPA will be subject only to the Agreement approved/adopted by the Cypress School District Board of Trustees. Approval is contingent/pending upon the Anaheim Union High School District Board of Trustees final approval.
